# RHAGAIR FOREWORD - OWEN TURNER

Croeso i'r adroddiad hwn ar Gronfa Budd Cymunedol Fferm Wynt Brenig, sy'n tynnu sylw at effaith y Gronfa rhwng 2023–2025 ac yn dangos yr ystod eang o brosiectau dan arweiniad cymunedau ar draws ardal y Brenig.

Mae'r prosiectau'n dangos cryfder, ymrwymiad a chreadigrwydd cymunedau lleol. O wella adeiladau a chyfleusterau chwaraeon i gefnogi diwylliant, yr amgylchedd a seilwaith lleol, mae'r Gronfa wedi gwneud gwahaniaeth go iawn i fywyd mewn cymunedau gwledig a lled-wledig, gan helpu grwpiau i aros yn wydn ac edrych ymlaen.

Dros y cyfnod hwn, mae'r Gronfa wedi ymateb i anghenion clir. Mae buddsoddi mewn effeithlonrwydd ynni, gwelliannau i adeiladau a gwaith cynnal a chadw wedi helpu i ddiogelu asedau cymunedol gwerthfawr. Ar yr un pryd, mae cefnogaeth i chwaraeon, diwylliant a lles wedi cryfhau cyfranogiad a chysylltiad cymdeithasol. Mae prosiectau llai ond pwysig—fel toiledau cyhoeddus, byrddau hysbysu a chaeau chwarae—yn dangos pa mor bwysig yw'r seilwaith sylfaenol sy'n helpu cymunedau i weithredu ac i groesawu pobl.

# CYFLWYNIAD INTRODUCTION

---

Mae Cronfa Budd Cymunedol Fferm Wynt Brenig yn bodoli i sicrhau bod cymunedau sydd agosaf at Fferm Wynt Brenig yn gweld buddion ymarferol a gwirioneddol o'r ynni adnewyddadwy a gynhyrchir yn eu hardal. Yn hytrach na bod yn fuddsoddiad unwaith yn unig, mae'r Gronfa'n darparu cefnogaeth barhaus i grwpiau a sefydliadau lleol, gan eu helpu i wella cyfleusterau, darparu gweithgareddau ac ymateb i anghenion y gymuned.

Mae'r Gronfa'n cael ei rheoli gan Cadwyn Clwyd, menter gymdeithasol sydd â gwreiddiau cryf yn y gymuned, ac mae'n gweithio'n agos gyda grwpiau lleol i'w harwain drwy'r broses ymgeisio a sicrhau bod cyllid yn cyrraedd prosiectau sy'n gwneud gwahaniaeth gwirioneddol.

Mae'r Gronfa'n cwmpasu ardal ddiffiniedig o amgylch Fferm Wynt Brenig, gan gefnogi cymunedau mewn rhannau o Sir Ddinbych a Chonwy. Mae'r ardaloedd gwledig hyn yn wynebu heriau fel mynediad cyfyngedig at wasanaethau, problemau trafnidiaeth a llai o gyfleoedd buddsoddi.

Mae'r Gronfa'n helpu i fynd i'r afael â'r rhain drwy roi adnoddau'n uniongyrchol i ddwylo lleol. Bob blwyddyn, mae'n dosbarthu grantiau a gynhyrchir gan y fferm wynt, gan ganolbwyntio ar brosiectau bach i ganolig sy'n darparu buddion clir i bobl leol. Mae cylchoedd cyllido rheolaidd yn caniatáu i grwpiau ymgeisio pan fyddant yn barod, yn hytrach na rhuthro i fodloni terfynau amser.

Wrth wraidd y Gronfa mae ffocws ar lesiant a gwydnwch cymunedol. Mae prosiectau a gefnogir yn aml yn gwella adeiladau, yn cynyddu effeithlonrwydd ynni, yn cefnogi chwaraeon a hamdden, yn gwella mannau cyhoeddus ac yn dod â phobl at ei gilydd.

The Brenig Wind Farm Community Benefit Fund exists to ensure that communities closest to the wind farm see practical and meaningful benefits from the renewable energy generated in their area. Rather than being a one-off investment, the Fund provides ongoing support to local groups and organisations, helping them improve facilities, deliver activities and respond effectively to the changing needs of their communities.

The Fund is managed by Cadwyn Clwyd, a social enterprise with strong local roots, working closely with community groups to guide them through the application process and ensure funding reaches projects that make a genuine and lasting difference.

The Fund covers a defined area around Brenig Wind Farm, supporting communities in parts of Denbighshire and Conwy. These rural areas often face challenges such as limited access to services, transport constraints and fewer opportunities for inward investment and development.

The Fund helps address these challenges by placing resources directly in local hands. Each year, it distributes grants generated by the wind farm, focusing on small to medium-sized projects that deliver clear and practical benefits for local people. Regular funding rounds allow groups to apply when they are ready, rather than feeling pressured to meet fixed deadlines.

At its core, the Fund focuses on strengthening community wellbeing and long-term resilience. Supported projects often improve buildings, increase energy efficiency, support sport and recreation, enhance public spaces and bring people together in ways that build stronger, more connected communities.



Mae'r Gronfa hefyd yn cyfrannu at flaenoriaethau ehangach megis cynaliadwyedd, lleihau costau, hybu iechyd a llesiant, dathlu diwylliant lleol a chryfhau'r Gymraeg.

Gwneir penderfyniadau ariannu drwy broses lywodraethu glir a thryloyw. Mae Cadwyn Clwyd yn gweinyddu'r Gronfa ac yn sicrhau bod ceisiadau'n cael eu hasesu'n deg yn erbyn meini prawf cytunedig. Mae'r broses yn seiliedig ar wybodaeth leol, gan sicrhau bod cyllid yn adlewyrchu blaenoriaethau'r cymunedau. Cedwir monitro yn gymesur, gan ganolbwyntio ar ganlyniadau yn hytrach na chreu baich diangen i grwpiau gwirfoddol.

Dros amser, mae'r Gronfa wedi cefnogi ystod eang o brosiectau — o uwchraddio neuaddau pentref a chlybiau chwaraeon i welliannau arbed ynni, offer, digwyddiadau a mentrau diwylliannol. Mewn llawer o achosion, mae cyllid Brenig yn gweithredu fel catalydd, gan alluogi grwpiau i ddenu cyllid ychwanegol, cynyddu cyfranogiad gwirfoddol a diogelu asedau lleol pwysig.

Mae'r Gronfa'n chwarae rôl bwysig wrth helpu cymunedau gwledig i addasu, ffynnu a chynllunio ar gyfer y dyfodol, gan sicrhau bod buddion ynni adnewyddadwy yn cael eu rhannu mewn ffordd ystyrlon a chynaliadwy.

The Fund also contributes to wider priorities including sustainability, reducing costs, improving health and wellbeing, celebrating local culture and strengthening the Welsh language.

Funding decisions are made through a clear and transparent governance process. Cadwyn Clwyd administers the Fund, ensuring applications are assessed fairly against agreed criteria. Decisions are informed by local knowledge, helping funding reflect community priorities. Monitoring is proportionate, focusing on outcomes rather than creating unnecessary burden for volunteer-led groups.

Over time, the Fund has supported a wide range of projects — from village hall and sports club upgrades to energy-saving improvements, equipment, events and cultural initiatives. In many cases, Brenig funding acts as a catalyst, enabling groups to secure additional funding, increase volunteer involvement and safeguard important local assets.

The Fund plays an important role in helping rural communities adapt, thrive and plan for the future, ensuring that the benefits of renewable energy are shared in a meaningful and lasting way.



Mae Brenig Wind Ltd wedi’w leoli yn ardal Cyngor Cymuned Nantglyn, a ward etholiadol Llanrhaeadr yng Nghinmeirch o fewn Cyngor Sir Ddinbych.

Mae Brenig Wind Ltd yn cynnig cronfa budd cymunedol gwerth bron i £4 miliwn dros gyfnod o 25 mlynedd ac mae modd i gymunedau sy’n amgylchynu’r fferm wynt fanteisio arni. Mae’r fferm wynt, sy’n eiddo i Brenig Wind Ltd, yn weithredol ers Mawrth 2019 a chanddo 16 tyrbin sy’n cynhyrchu 2.35MW. Mae cyfanswm capasiti ynni wedi’i osod yn 37.6MW – sy’n ddigon i gynnal dros 30,000 o dai pob blwyddyn. Caiff y gronfa ei dyrannu i fentrau a phrosiectau cymunedol.

Caiff y gronfa ei gweinyddu gan Cadwyn Clwyd a Phanel Brenig Wind Ltd sy’n gyfrifol am yr holl benderfyniadau ynghylch sut caiff y cyllid ei ddyfarnu. Ymysg aelodau’r Panel mae:

Brenig Wind Limited is located in the Community Council area of Nantglyn and the electoral ward of Llanrhaeadr yng Nghinmeirch within Denbighshire County Council.

Brenig Wind Ltd provides a community benefit fund of almost £4 million over 25 years and is available for communities surrounding the windfarm. The windfarm owned by Brenig Wind Ltd became operational in March 2019 and has 16 turbines each of 2.35MW, giving a total installed capacity of 37.6MW – enough to power over 30,000 homes every year. The fund is distributed to local community projects and initiatives.

The fund is administered by Cadwyn Clwyd, all decisions on how funds are awarded are made by the Brenig Wind Ltd Panel. The Panel members are:

# TROSOLWG ERS YR ADRODDIAD DIWETHAF

## OVERVIEW SINCE THE LAST REPORT

---

Dros y tair blynedd diwethaf, mae Cronfa Budd Cymunedol Fferm Wynt Brenig wedi cefnogi ystod eang o brosiectau a arweinir gan y gymuned ar draws yr ardal gymwys, gan adlewyrchu anghenion lleol sy'n newid a ffocws parhaus ar wydnwch gwledig, llesiant a chynaliadwyedd. Mae'r prosiectau a ariannwyd yn dangos symudiad clir tuag at fuddsoddi mewn asedau cymunedol, ynghyd â mwy o sylw i effeithlonrwydd ynni, pwysau costau byw, hygyrchedd a darpariaeth gynhwysol.

Mae cyfran sylweddol o'r cyllid wedi cefnogi gwelliannau a chynaliadwyedd adeiladau cymunedol. Mae neuaddau pentref, canolfannau a chyfleusterau chwaraeon wedi derbyn uwchraddiadau megis to, systemau gwresogi, insiweiddio, ffenestri a goleuadau. Mae'r buddsoddiadau hyn yn ymateb i gostau ynni cynyddol a seilwaith sy'n heneiddio, gan helpu i leihau costau rhedeg a sicrhau bod adeiladau'n ddiogel ac yn groesawgar. Mewn llawer o ardaloedd gwledig, mae'r cyfleusterau hyn yn ofodau cymunedol hanfodol.

Mae'r Gronfa wedi cefnogi'n gynyddol brosiectau effeithlonrwydd ynni a chynaliadwyedd, gan helpu sefydliadau i reoli pwysau ariannol tra'n cyd-fynd â blaenoriaethau amgylcheddol. Mae cyllid Brenig wedi galluogi grwpiau i ddiogelu cyfleusterau at y dyfodol a fyddai fel arall yn anghynaliadwy.

Mae buddsoddi mewn chwaraeon, gweithgarwch corfforol a llesiant yn parhau'n gryf. Mae clybiau wedi derbyn cefnogaeth ar gyfer offer a gwelliannau i gyfleusterau, gan alluogi cyfranogiad ar draws pob oedran a chyfrannu at iechyd corfforol, llesiant meddyliol a chysylltiad cymdeithasol. Mewn llawer o achosion, mae cyllid wedi helpu i gynyddu aelodaeth ac ymestyn gweithgareddau.

Over the last three years, the Brenig Wind Farm Community Benefit Fund has supported a wide range of community-led projects across the eligible area, reflecting changing local needs and a continued focus on rural resilience, wellbeing and sustainability. Funded projects show a clear shift towards practical investment in community assets, alongside growing attention to energy-efficiency, cost-of-living pressures, accessibility and inclusive provision.

A significant proportion of funding has supported the improvement and long-term sustainability of community buildings. Village halls, centres and sports facilities have received upgrades such as roofing, heating, insulation, windows and lighting. These investments respond to rising energy costs and ageing infrastructure, helping reduce running costs while ensuring buildings remain safe and welcoming. In many rural areas, these facilities are vital shared spaces supporting social, cultural and support services.

The Fund has increasingly supported energy-efficiency and sustainability projects, helping organisations manage financial pressures while aligning with environmental priorities. Brenig funding has often enabled groups to future-proof facilities that might otherwise become unsustainable.

Investment in sport, physical activity and wellbeing remains strong. Clubs have received support for equipment, facility improvements and maintenance, enabling participation across all age groups and contributing to physical health, mental wellbeing and social connection. In many cases, funding has helped increase membership and extend activities year-round.

Mae diogelwch cymunedol, hygyrchedd a chynhwysiant hefyd wedi bod yn themâu allweddol. Mae cyllid wedi cefnogi CCTV, mynediad gwell a chyfleusterau wedi'u huwchraddio ar gyfer pobl ag anableddau, gan sicrhau bod mannau cymunedol yn hygyrch i bawb.

Mae'r Gronfa yn parhau i gefnogi gweithgareddau diwylliannol, treftadaeth a'r Gymraeg, gan gryfhau hunaniaeth leol ac annog cyfranogiad rhwng cenedlaethau.

Yn fwy diweddar, mae prosiectau wedi ymateb i heriau cymdeithasol megis unigedd, yr argyfwng costau byw a mynediad at wasanaethau. Mae cyllid wedi cefnogi mannau cynnes, mentrau bwyd a chyfleusterau cymorth, gan ddangos hyblygrwydd y Gronfa wrth ymateb i anghenion sy'n datblygu.

Ar draws pob cylch, mae cyllid Brenig wedi gweithredu fel catalydd—gan ddenu cyllid ychwanegol, ymdrech wirfoddol a chefnogaeth partneriaeth. Er bod maint llawer o grantiau yn gymharol fach, mae'r effaith wedi bod yn sylweddol wrth gynnal asedau a sefydliadau cymunedol.

Yn gyffredinol, mae'r Gronfa yn parhau i chwarae rôl hanfodol wrth alluogi atebion ymarferol a arweinir yn lleol i heriau gwledig, gan helpu cymunedau i addasu a ffynnu.

Community safety, accessibility and inclusion have also been key themes. Funding has supported CCTV, improved access, safer entrances and upgraded facilities for people with disabilities. These projects ensure community spaces remain inclusive and accessible to all.

The Fund continues to support cultural, heritage and Welsh-language activity, strengthening local identity and encouraging intergenerational participation.

More recently, projects have responded to wider social challenges such as isolation, the cost-of-living crisis and access to services. Funding has supported warm spaces, food initiatives and community support facilities, demonstrating the Fund's flexibility in responding to emerging needs.

Across all rounds, Brenig funding has often acted as a catalyst—leveraging additional funding, volunteer effort and partnership support. Despite the relatively modest size of many grants, the impact has been significant in sustaining community assets and organisations.

Overall, the Fund continues to play a vital role in enabling practical, locally-driven solutions to rural challenges, supporting communities to adapt and thrive.





Mae **Hwb Uwchaled** yn ganolfan gymunedol hanfodol sy'n gwasanaethu ardal wledig, gan ddarparu gwasanaethau fel llyfrgell, sesiynau cyngor a manau cynnes. Mae'n cael ei ddefnyddio'n rheolaidd gan drigolion a fyddai fel arall yn teithio pellteroedd sylweddol i gael mynediad at gymorth a chysylltiad cymdeithasol.

Cefnogodd cyllid Brenig waith adnewyddu, gan gynnwys gwelliannau i loriau, ffenestri, goleuadau, inswleiddio a chyfleusterau cegin. Mae hyn wedi gwella cysur ac effeithlonrwydd ynni, lleihau costau, a sicrhau bod yr hwb yn parhau'n ofod hygyrch sy'n cefnogi lles a gwytnwch yn y gymuned.



**Hwb Uwchaled** is a vital community hub serving a rural area, providing services such as a local library, advice sessions and warm-space provision. It is regularly used by residents who would otherwise travel significant distances to access support and social contact.

Brenig funding supported refurbishment works, including improvements to flooring, windows, lighting, insulation and kitchen facilities. This has improved comfort and energy efficiency, reduced costs, and ensured the hub continues as an accessible space supporting wellbeing and resilience in the community.



## Menter Iaith Conwy

Mae Menter Iaith Conwy yn hyrwyddo'r Gymraeg drwy weithgareddau diwylliannol, digwyddiadau a gwirfoddoli, gan gefnogi teuluoedd, pobl ifanc a grwpiau i'w defnyddio'n ddyddiol.

Drwy gyllid aml-flwyddyn Brenig, mae'r rhaglen wedi ehangu, cryfhau arweinyddiaeth wirfoddol a chynyddu cyfranogiad. Mae hyn yn cefnogi bywiogrwydd ieithyddol a gwydnwch diwylliannol o fewn bywyd cymunedol.

## Menter Iaith Conwy

Menter Iaith Conwy promotes Welsh through cultural activities, events and volunteering, supporting families, young people and groups to use the language in everyday life.

Through multi-year Brenig funding, the programme has expanded, strengthened volunteer leadership and increased participation. This supports linguistic vitality and cultural resilience within community life.

## Toileddau Cyhoeddus Llansannan – Menter Bro Aled Cyf

Mae'r toiledau cyhoeddus yn Llansannan yn gyfleuster bach ond hanfodol i drigolion, ymwelwyr a theithwyr, gan gynnwys cerddwyr a beicwyr. Cyn y gwaith, roedd difrod storm wedi gwanhau'r to, gan greu risg o gau'r cyfleuster.

Cefnogodd cyllid Brenig waith ail-doi brys, gan sicrhau bod yr adeilad yn ddiogel, yn lân ac yn wydn i'r tywydd. Mae'r prosiect yn cefnogi lles cymunedol a bywiogrwydd canol y pentref.

## Llansannan Public Toilets – Menter Bro Aled Cyf

The public toilets in Llansannan are a small but essential facility for residents, visitors and travellers, including walkers and cyclists. Prior to works, storm damage had weakened the roof, creating a risk of closure.

Brenig funding supported urgent re-roofing, ensuring the building remains safe, clean and weatherproof. The project supports community wellbeing and the vitality of the village centre.



Mae **Cymdeithas Gymunedol Llanfwrog** yn rheoli The Centre Llanfwrog, cyfleuster aml-ddefnydd mawr sy'n gwasanaethu Rhuthun a'r ardal wledig gyfagos. Mae'r ganolfan yn cynnal amrywiaeth eang o weithgareddau ac yn ased cymunedol pwysig.

Cefnogodd cyllid Brenig welliannau effeithlonrwydd ynni, gan gynnwys goleuadau LED a mesurau ynni adnewyddadwy, ynghyd ag estyniad caffi. Mae hyn wedi lleihau costau, cryfhau gwydnwch ariannol a sicrhau bod y ganolfan yn parhau i ddarparu gwasanaethau cynhwysol.



**Llanfwrog Community Association** manages Llanfwrog Community Centre, a large multi-use facility serving Ruthin and surrounding rural areas. The Centre hosts a wide range of activities and is an important community asset.

Brenig funding supported energy-efficiency improvements, including LED lighting and renewable measures, alongside a café extension. This has reduced costs, strengthened financial resilience and ensured the Centre continues to provide inclusive services.



Mae **Canolfan Gerdd William Mathias** yn darparu rhaglenni cerdd cynhwysol sy'n defnyddio creadigrwydd i wella lles a lleihau unigedd. Mae'r fenter "Cerddoriaeth er Lles" yn dod â cherddoriaeth i gymunedau, gan gynnwys cartrefi gofal a chyngherddau dydd i bobl hŷn.

Cefnogodd cyllid Brenig sesiynau dwyieithog a gyrhaeddodd bobl na fyddent fel arall yn ymgysylltu â'r celfyddydau. Mae'r prosiect yn dangos sut gall gweithgaredd diwylliannol gefnogi iechyd meddwl, cysylltiad cymdeithasol ac ymgysylltiad rhwng cenedlaethau.

**Canolfan Gerdd William Mathias** delivers inclusive music programmes that use creativity to improve wellbeing and reduce isolation. The "Music for Good" initiative brings music into community settings, including care homes and daytime concerts for older people.

Brenig funding supported bilingual sessions reaching people who might not otherwise engage with the arts. The project shows how cultural activity can support mental health, social connection and intergenerational engagement.



## Ymddiriedolaeth Natur Gogledd Cymru Prosiect Gweilch Brenig

Mae Prosiect Gweilch Brenig yn fenter gadwraeth bwysig sydd hefyd yn atyniad poblogaidd i ymwelwyr ac yn safle monitro bioamrywiaeth. Mae'n dibynnu ar wirfoddolwyr ac ymgysylltiad cyhoeddus i gefnogi cadwraeth ac addysg.

Cefnogodd cyllid Brenig welliannau i ddehongli, hygyrchedd, offer monitro ac adnoddau gwirfoddolwyr. Mae hyn wedi gwella profiad ymwelwyr, casglu data a llwyddiant bridio, tra'n cyfrannu at dwristiaeth gynaliadwy ac ymwybyddiaeth amgylcheddol.



## North Wales Wildlife Trust Brenig Osprey Project

The Brenig Osprey Project is a significant conservation initiative and popular visitor attraction, supporting biodiversity monitoring. It relies on volunteers and public engagement to deliver conservation and education.

Brenig funding supported improvements to interpretation, accessibility, monitoring equipment and volunteer resources. This has enhanced visitor experience, data collection and breeding success, while supporting sustainable tourism and environmental awareness.



Mae **Cyngor Bro Llanfihangel Glyn Myfyr** yn cynnal cae chwarae pwysig yng nghanol y pentref, sy'n cael ei ddefnyddio gan ystod eang o grwpiau lleol.

Yn dilyn gwaith draenio blaenorol ar y cae, cefnogodd cyllid Brenig osod ffens newydd o amgylch y safle er mwyn ei ddiogelu a'i adfer i safon addas ar gyfer defnydd aml-bwrpas. Mae'r gwaith wedi galluogi'r cae i gael ei ddefnyddio'n ddiogel ac yn rheolaidd, gan wella ansawdd y cyfleuster a chynyddu cyfleoedd ar gyfer chwaraeon a gweithgareddau cymunedol.

**Cyngor Bro Llanfihangel Glyn Myfyr** maintains an important village playing field at the heart of the community, used by a range of local groups.

Following earlier drainage works to improve the condition of the field, Brenig funding supported the installation of new fencing around the site to secure the area and restore it to a suitable standard for multi-purpose use. The improvements have enabled the field to be used safely and regularly, enhancing the quality of the facility and increasing opportunities for sport and community activity.

Mae **Tŷ Clwyd** yn ganolfan Girlguiding breswyl sy'n cynnig cyfleoedd dysgu awyr agored a datblygiad i bobl ifanc ledled Cymru. Mae'r adeilad hefyd yn cael ei ddefnyddio'n helaeth gan y gymuned, ac roedd costau ynni cynyddol wedi dod yn her sylweddol.

Cefnogodd cyllid Brenig uwchraddiad llawn i oleuadau LED, gan leihau'r defnydd o drydan tua 50 y cant. Mae'r buddsoddiad hwn wedi gwella cynaliadwyedd y ganolfan, gan helpu i gadw gweithgareddau preswyl yn fforddiadwy, tra'n parhau i ddarparu cyfleuster hanfodol i'r gymuned. Mae hefyd wedi hyrwyddo datblygiad ieuenctid a chyfrifoldeb amgylcheddol.

**Tŷ Clwyd** is a residential Girlguiding centre offering outdoor learning and development opportunities for young people across Wales. The building is also heavily used by the community, and rising energy costs had become a significant challenge.

Brenig funding supported a full LED lighting upgrade, reducing electricity use by around 50 per cent. This investment has improved the centre's sustainability, helping to keep residential activities affordable, whilst also continuing to provide an essential facility for the community. It has also promoted youth development and environmental responsibility.





Mae **Sioe Cyffylliog a Bontuchel** yn ddigwyddiad pentref hirsefydlog sy'n dathlu bywyd gwledig, diwylliant a chyfranogiad cymunedol. Caiff ei threfnu gan wirfoddolwyr ac mae'n dod â phobl o bob oed ynghyd.

Cefnogodd cyllid Brenig brynu offer i foderneiddio'r sioe, gwella diogelwch a chynyddu cyfleoedd i blant a phobl ifanc. Mae hyn wedi helpu i ddiogelu'r traddodiad a chryfhau balchder cymunedol a gweithgarwch lleol.

**Sioe Cyffylliog a Bontuchel** is a long-established village show celebrating rural life, culture and community participation. Run by volunteers, it brings together people of all ages.

Brenig funding supported new equipment to modernise the show, improve safety and increase opportunities for children and young people. This has helped secure the tradition while strengthening community pride and local activity.



Mae **Canolfan Eirianfa** yn ganolfan gymunedol brysur a ddefnyddir gan dros 30 o grwpiau a nifer fawr o drigolion lleol. Cyn y gwaith, roedd costau gwresogi uchel a cholli gwres yn rhoi pwysau ar gyllid ac yn effeithio ar gysur defnyddwyr.

Cefnogodd cyllid Brenig waith inswleiddio, gan leihau defnydd ynni a gwella cysur thermol. Mae hyn wedi helpu i sicrhau cynaliadwyedd y ganolfan fel gofod diogel a chroesawgar.



**Canolfan Eirianfa** is a busy community centre used by over 30 groups and many local residents. Prior to works, high heating costs and heat loss placed pressure on finances and affected user comfort.

Brenig funding supported insulation works, reducing energy use and improving thermal comfort. This has helped secure the centre's sustainability as a safe, welcoming space.

Mae **Clwb Bowlio Dinbych** yn glwb chwaraeon cymunedol hirsefydlog wedi'i leoli ym Mharc Isaf, gan ddarparu gweithgarwch corfforol hygyrch i bobl o bob oed, yn enwedig trigolion hŷn. Mae cynnal arwyneb chwarae o safon uchel yn hanfodol ar gyfer cyfranogiad a diogelwch.

Mae cyllid Brenig wedi cefnogi buddsoddiad fesul cam mewn offer arbenigol ar gyfer cynnal y lawnt, gan leihau costau hirdymor a'r ddibyniaeth ar beiriannau llogi. Mae'r uwchraddiadau wedi gwella amodau chwarae, cefnogi aelodaeth sy'n tyfu ac wedi galluogi'r clwb i gynnal gemau cystadleuol, gan gryfhau ei rôl fel ased cymunedol gwerthfawr.



**Denbigh Bowling Club** is a long-established community sports club based in Lower Park, providing accessible physical activity for people of all ages, particularly older residents. Maintaining a high-quality playing surface is essential for participation and safety.

Brenig funding has supported phased investment in specialist green-maintenance equipment, reducing long-term costs and reliance on hired machinery. The upgrades have improved playing conditions, supported growing membership and enabled the club to host competitive fixtures, strengthening its role as a valued community asset.

Mae **Clwb Rygbi Rhuthun** yn ganolfan chwaraeon a chymdeithasol bwysig, gan gefnogi dros 400 o chwaraewyr yn wythnosol ar draws grwpiau oedran a rhywiau. Mae ei gyfleusterau'n cael eu defnyddio'n helaeth ac yn ganolog i fywyd cymunedol yn Rhuthun. Mae cyllid Brenig wedi cefnogi gwelliannau seilwaith, gan gynnwys goleuadau llifoleuadau ynni-effeithlon a diogelwch CCTV gwell. Mae buddsoddiad mewn storfa ar gyfer timau ieuencid poblogaidd hefyd wedi'i gefnogi.

Mae'r gwelliannau hyn yn cynyddu diogelwch, yn ymestyn defnydd drwy'r flwyddyn, yn lleihau costau ynni ac yn diogelu asedau cymunedol, gan sicrhau y gall y clwb barhau i ddarparu buddion iechyd, llesiant a chynhwysiant i'r ardal ehangach.

**Ruthin Rugby Club** is a key sporting and social hub, supporting over 400 players weekly across age groups and genders. Its facilities are heavily used and central to community life in Ruthin.

Brenig funding has supported infrastructure improvements, including energy-efficient floodlighting and enhanced CCTV security. Investment in storage for the youth teams has also been supported. These improvements enhance safety, extend year-round use, reduce energy costs and protect community assets, ensuring the club can continue delivering health, wellbeing and inclusion benefits to the wider area.

The Brenig Wind Farm Community Benefit Fund continues to deliver a wide range of measurable outputs, including improvements to community buildings, investment in energy efficiency, support for sport and wellbeing activities, and the protection of essential local infrastructure.

As can be seen from the map above, there has been an effective geographic distribution of grants across the Brenig area.

These outputs translate into meaningful outcomes for rural communities, including reduced operating costs, improved wellbeing, increased participation, and strengthened community resilience. Over time, the Fund has contributed to longer-term impacts such as sustainable community infrastructure, improved environmental performance, and stronger, more connected communities.



Rhwng Rowndiau 8 a 13, mae Cronfa Brenig wedi cefnogi ystod eang o brosiectau dan arweiniad cymunedau ar draws yr ardal. Mae hyn yn cynnwys 11 prosiect gwella adeiladau, ynghyd â gwaith insiwleiddio, gwresogi, a gwelliannau i geginau a tho i gryfhau cyfleusterau cymunedol. Mae buddsoddi mewn effeithlonrwydd ynni wedi darparu goleuadau LED, uwchraddio gwresogi a mesurau ynni adnewyddadwy. Mae'r Gronfa hefyd wedi cefnogi chwaraeon a hamdden drwy fuddsoddi mewn offer, gwelliannau i gyfleusterau ac uwchraddio meysydd, tra bod prosiectau seilwaith cymunedol, diwylliant a'r Gymraeg, ynghyd â mentrau treftadaeth a rhaglenni cymunedol—wedi helpu i gryfhau hunaniaeth, cyfranogiad a lles lleol.

Between Rounds 8 and 13, the Brenig Fund has supported a wide range of community-led projects across the area. This includes 11 building improvement projects, along with insulation, heating, kitchen and roof upgrades to strengthen community facilities. Investment in energy efficiency has delivered LED lighting, heating improvements and renewable energy measures. The Fund has also supported sport and recreation through equipment purchases, facility enhancements and pitch upgrades, while community infrastructure, cultural activity and Welsh language initiatives—alongside heritage and community programmes—have helped strengthen local identity, participation and wellbeing.

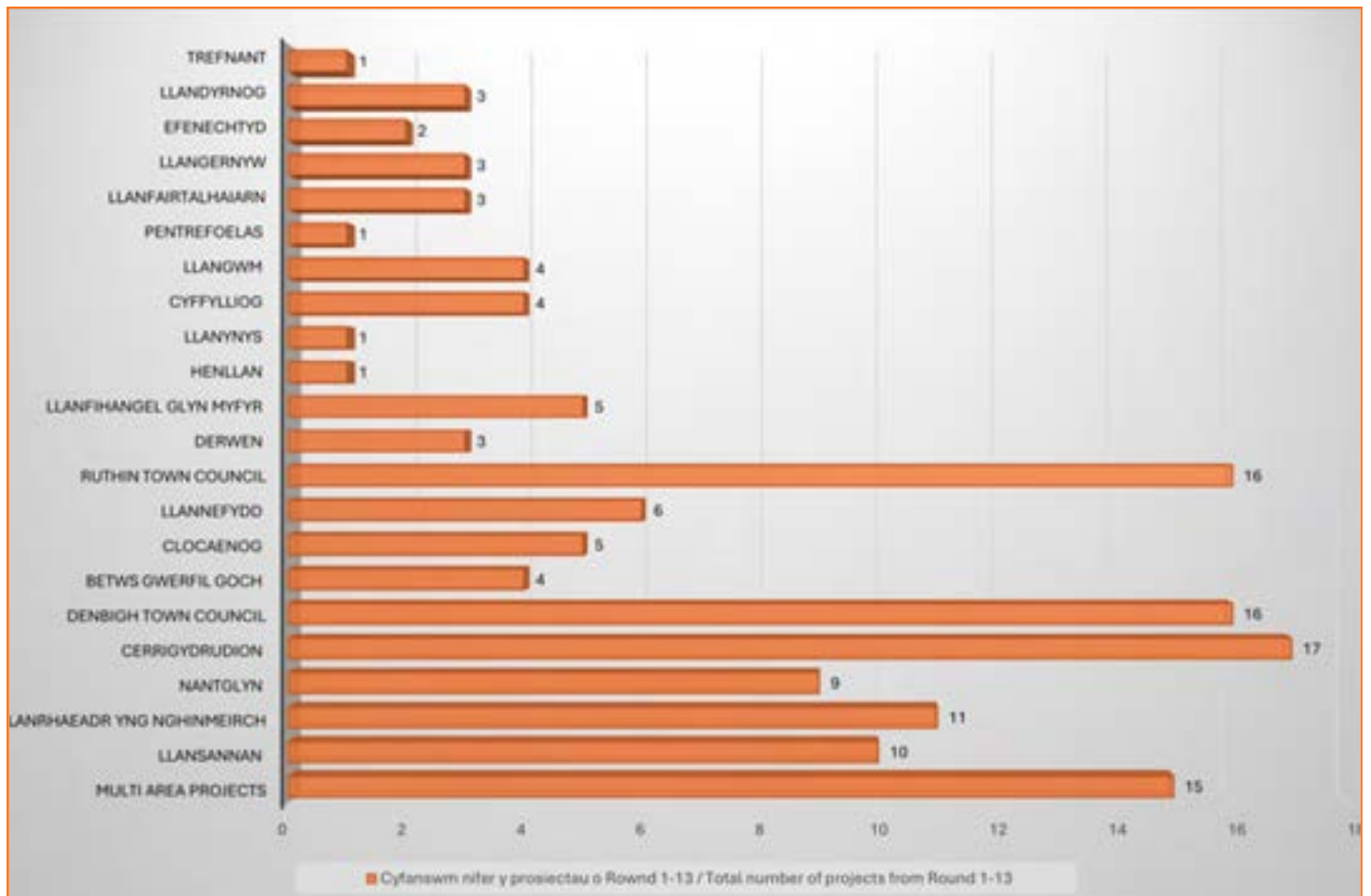

# ADOLYGU'R GRANTIAU    REVIEWING THE GRANTS

**Trosolwg.** Rhwng rowndiau 8 a 13, cefnogodd Cronfa Budd Cymunedol Brenig 65 o brosiectau gyda chyfanswm cyllid cymeradwy o £571,048.49. Mae hyn yn rhoi gwerth grant cyfartalog o £8,785.36 fesul prosiect. Ar draws y rhaglen lawn o Rownd 1 i Rownd 13, cefnogodd y Gronfa 136 o brosiectau gyda chyfanswm cyllid cymeradwy o £999,744.46, gan roi grant cyfartalog cyffredinol o £7,351.06.

**Beth mae hyn yn ei ddangos.** Mae'r rowndiau diweddarach yn cyfrif am ychydig llai na hanner yr holl brosiectau a gefnogwyd, ond cyfran fwy o gyfanswm y buddsoddiad. Mae'r grant cyfartalog yn Rowndiau 8-13 (£8,785.36) £2,747.39 yn uwch na'r cyfartaledd ar draws Rowndiau 1-7 (£6,037.97), cynnydd o 45.5%. Mae hyn yn awgrymu bod y rhaglen wedi symud dros amser tuag at wobrau mwy a mwy strategol.

**Casgliad.** Mae'r data yn dangos cronfa aeddfedu: mae rowndiau cynharach yn dosbarthu cefnogaeth ar draws nifer fwy o ddyfarniadau llai, tra bod y rowndiau mwy diweddar wedi cefnogi prosiectau llai ond gwerth uwch. Mae'r patrwm hwn yn gyson â buddsoddiad cyfalaf cryfach, cynlluniau seilwaith cymunedol mwy uchelgeisiol, a chostau cyflenwi ar raddfa fwy mewn rowndiau diweddarach.

**Overview.** Between Rounds 8 and 13, the Brenig Community Benefit Fund supported 65 projects with total approved funding of £571,048.49. This gives an average grant value of £8,785.36 per project. Across the full programme from Round 1 to Round 13, the Fund supported 136 projects with total approved funding of £999,744.46, giving an overall average grant of £7,351.06.

**What this shows.** The later rounds account for just under half of all projects supported, but a larger share of total investment. The average grant in Rounds 8-13 (£8,785.36) is £2,747.39 higher than the average across Rounds 1-7 (£6,037.97), an increase of 45.5%. This suggests the programme has shifted over time toward larger and more strategic awards.

**Conclusion.** The data points to a maturing fund: earlier rounds distributed support across a larger number of smaller awards, while the more recent rounds have backed fewer but higher-value projects. This pattern is consistent with stronger capital investment, more ambitious community infrastructure schemes, and larger-scale delivery costs in later rounds.

Ar draws Rowndiau 8–13 Cronfa Budd Cymunedol Brenig, mae gweithgarwch buddsoddi cymunedol wedi parhau i fod yn gyson ac yn effeithiol yn lleol. Gyda'i gilydd, mae'r chwe rownd hyn yn cynrychioli cyllid parhaus ar gyfer sefydliadau ar lawr gwlad, gwelliannau seilwaith, a mentrau sy'n hyrwyddo lles, cynhwysiant a stiwardiaeth amgylcheddol ledled yr ardal gymwys.

Mae'r Gronfa yn parhau i ddangos dosbarthiad cytbwys ar draws blaenoriaethau thematig, gan adlewyrchu anghenion lleol rheolaidd a chyfleoedd esblygol ar gyfer gwella cymunedau. Mae'r patrwm thematig ar draws pob rownd yn dangos pwyslais cryf ar gyfleusterau cymunedol, lles, a chynhwysiant, gydag amrywiaeth gynyddol mewn prosiectau amgylcheddol, diwylliannol a threftadaeth.

Mae'r Gronfa hefyd yn parhau i annog cydweithio rhwng sefydliadau lleol, trosoli gallu gwirfoddoli, a chefnogi gwelliannau cyfalaf ar raddfa fach sy'n gwneud gwahaniaethau mesuradwy i gymunedau gwledig.

Across Rounds 8–13 of the Brenig Community Benefit Fund, community investment activity has remained consistent and locally impactful. Taken together, these six rounds represent sustained funding for grassroots organisations, infrastructure improvements, and initiatives that promote wellbeing, inclusion, and environmental stewardship throughout the eligible area.

The Fund continues to demonstrate a balanced distribution across thematic priorities, reflecting both recurring local needs and evolving opportunities for community enhancement. The thematic pattern across all rounds shows a strong emphasis on community facilities, wellbeing, and inclusion, with increasing diversity in environmental, cultural, and heritage projects.

The Fund continues to encourage collaboration between local organisations, leverage volunteer capacity, and support small-scale capital improvements that make measurable differences to rural communities.
