

We will be running 2 x 10 weeks cohorts (16 - 25y, 25y+) to achieve the Agored Level 1 Qualification in Outdoor Learning with Coppice products. This will cover Safety in the Outdoors, Sustainable Use of Natural resources and Coppice Products), 2 First Aid at Work qualifications and 4 days of Volunteering and enrichment activities. All our sessions will take place in the woodland and workshops. The intention is that each participant will complete a chair, or a stool, made from a tree that they have coppiced from the woods.
