RHAGAIR FOREWORD

Ers lansio Cronfa Budd Cymunedol Brenig Wind Ltd mae wedi cynorthwyo prosiectau'n uniongyrchol ledled ei maes budd ac mae'n gyfle gwerth chweil i gymunedau cefn gwlad. Mae Cadwyn Clwyd, y gweinyddwr cronfa leol, eisoes wedi dyfarnu £356,283 i 59 prosiect lleol yn ystod pum rownd ariannu i grwpiau lleol tuag at ystod o wahanol brosiectau ac wedi'u cynorthwyo i drosoli mwy fyth. Mae'n bleser mawr gennym ni weld ehangder ac ansawdd y prosiectau cymunedol y mae Brenig yn eu cefnogi ynghyd ag effaith gadarnhaol y gronfa ar y cymunedau hynny.

Since its launch the Brenig Wind Ltd Community Benefit Fund has directly helped projects across its area of benefit. It's a fantastic opportunity for rural communities. Cadwyn Clwyd, the local fund administrator, has already awarded £356,283 to 59 local projects in five rounds of funding to community groups for a range of different projects and helped them leverage even more. We're pleased to see the breadth and quality of community projects supported by Brenig, and the positive impact on those communities.

CYFLWYNIAD INTRODUCTION

Mae Brenig Wind Ltd yn weithredol yn ardal Cyngor Cymuned Nantglyn a ward etholaethol Llanrhaeadr yng Nghinmeirch yng Nghyngor Sir Ddinbych.

Mae Brenig Wind Ltd yn cynnig cronfa budd cymunedol gwerth bron i £4 miliwn dros gyfnod o 25 mlynedd ac mae modd i gymunedau sy'n amgylchynu'r fferm wynt fanteisio arni. Mae'r fferm wynt, sy'n eiddo i Brenig Wind Ltd, yn weithredol ers Mawrth 2019 a chanddo 16 tyrbin sy'n cynhyrchu 2.35MW. Mae cyfanswm capasiti ynni wedi'i osod yn 37.6MW – sy'n ddigon i gynnal dros 30,000 o dai pob blwyddyn. Caiff y gronfa ei dyrannu i fentrau a phrosiectau cymunedol.

Caiff y gronfa ei gweinyddu gan Cadwyn Clwyd a Phanel Brenig Wind Ltd sy'n gyfrifol am yr holl benderfyniadau ynghylch sut caiff y cyllid ei ddyfarnu. Ymysg aelodau'r Panel mae:

Brenig Wind Limited is located in the Community Council area of Nantglyn and the electoral ward of Llanrhaeadr yng Nghinmeirch within Denbighshire County Council.

Brenig Wind Ltd provides a community benefit fund of almost £4 million over 25 years and is available for communities surrounding the windfarm. The windfarm owned by Brenig Wind Ltd became operational in March 2019 and has 16 turbines each of 2.35MW, giving a total installed capacity of 37.6MW – enough to power over 30,000 homes every year. The fund is distributed to local community projects and initiatives.

The fund is administered by Cadwyn Clwyd, all decisions on how funds are awarded are made by the Brenig Wind Ltd Panel. Panel members include:

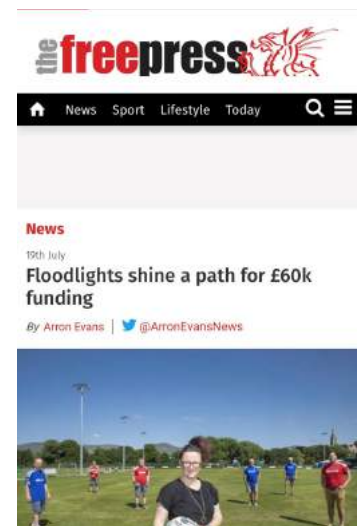
YMGYSYLLTU Â'R GYMUNED, MARCHNATA A CHYFATHREBU COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT, MARKETING AND COMMUNICATIONS

Mae Cadwyn Clwyd a'i mudiadau partner yn parhau i ymwneud gyda'r gymuned i ddatblygu prosiectau. At hyn, mae Cadwyn Clwyd yn cydweithio'n agos gyda Swyddogion Datblygu Cymunedol Awdurdod Lleol yng Nghyngor Sir Ddinbych a Chyngor Bwrdeistref Sirol Conwy i gefnogi cymunedau i ddatblygu prosiectau ac ymgeisio ar gyfer cyllid Brenig yn ogystal â chynorthwyo gydag adnabod a throsoli cyllid cyfatebol.

Yn ystod y 12 mis diwethaf, bu i Cadwyn Clwyd gynnal dau ddiwyddiad galw heibio rhithiol ym mis Chwefror ac Awst 2021. Nod y digwyddiadau hyn oedd cynnig cyngor ac arweiniad i grwpiau oedd yn dymuno cyflwyno ceisiadau ar gyfer cyllid Brenig. Roedd y digwyddiadau'n boblogaidd dros ben a bu i'r ymgeiswyr arfaethedig dderbyn cyngor ac arweiniad ar sut i fanteisio ar gefnogaeth gan Brenig.

Ar y cyd â phartneriaid Cadwyn Clwyd, Ceidiog Communications, mae ymgyrch i'r wasg parhaus ar waith gyda datganiadau i'r wasg sy'n amlgu'r cyllid sydd wedi'i ddyrannu a'r cyfleoedd ynghlwm â'r gronfa. Mae Clwb Pêl Droed Rhuthun a Beiciau Trydan Hiraethog eill dau wedi'u crybwyll fel prosiectau sydd wedi derbyn cefnogaeth. Cafodd y straeon eu cyhoeddi ar 10 gwefan newyddion a phapurau newydd megis North Wales Weekly News, Daily Post a'r Denbighshire Free Press. Ym mis Gorffennaf 2021, cafodd Clwb Rygbi Rhuthun a Brenig Wind Ltd eu hyrwyddo ar y Teledu fel rhan o adroddiad BBC Newyddion Cymru ar gronfeydd Budd Cymunedol Ffermydd Gwynt yng Nghymru. At hyn, fe gafodd y prosiect 'Nerth dy Ben' ei grybwyll ar raglen HENO ar S4C.

Yn ogystal, fe gafodd y bedwaredd a'r bumed rownd ariannu, y prosiectau sydd wedi derbyn grantiau a straeon newyddion da eu hyrwyddo ar dudalennau cyfryngau cymdeithasol a gwefan Cadwyn Clwyd. Cafodd y rowndiau ariannu eu rhannu mewn e-byst uniongyrchol at gynghorau cymuned, grwpiau cymunedol, mudiadau partner a rhanddeiliaid.



Cadwyn Clwyd and its partner organisations continue to engage with the local community in the development of projects. Cadwyn works closely with Local Authority Community Development Officers in both Denbighshire CC and Conwy CBC to support communities to develop projects and apply for Brenig funds as well as assisting to identify and lever match funding.

During the last 12 months, Cadwyn Clwyd held two virtual funding drop-in events to provide advice and guidance to groups wishing to apply for Brenig funds. These were held in February 2021 and August 2021 and were well attended with potential applicants receiving advice and guidance on accessing support from Brenig.

In partnership with Cadwyn Clwyd's associates Ceidiog Communications, an on-going press campaign has been undertaken with press releases highlighting the funding awarded and the opportunities offered by the fund. Both Ruthin Football Club and Hiraethog Electric Bikes have featured as projects receiving support. The stories appeared on 10 news websites and newspapers such as North Wales Weekly News, Daily Post and the Denbighshire Free Press. In July 2021, Ruthin Rugby Club and Brenig Wind Ltd received TV coverage on a BBC News Wales report on Windfarm Community Benefit funds in Wales and the 'Nerth dy Ben' project received coverage on S4C's HENO programme.

Communication has also been undertaken through Cadwyn Clwyd's social media channels and website to highlight the fourth and fifth funding rounds, projects awarded grants and good news stories. The funding rounds have been communicated via direct emails to community councils, community groups, partner organisations and stakeholders.

Er gwaethaf heriau'r pandemig, bu i nifer sylweddol gyflwyno ceisiadau ar gyfer y gronfa gyda phrosiectau wedi'u cefnogi yn parhau i fod ar waith ar lawr gwlad ac mewn cymunedau. Mae'r prosiectau'n amrywio'n sylweddol ac maen nhw'n cyflawni'r blaenoriaethau sydd wedi'u hadnabod gan y gymuned fel rhan o'r ymgynghoriad ar gyfer y gronfa.

Yn ystod y 12 mis diwethaf, fe lanswyd rownd 4 a 5 y gronfa ac fe ddyfarnwyd cyfanswm o £88,411 i grwpiau.

Despite the challenges of the pandemic, the fund has received a significant number of applications with supported projects still being delivered on the ground and in local communities. The range of projects are varied and delivers against the priorities identified by the community as part of the consultation for the fund.

During the last 12 months, round 4 and round 5 of the fund was launched with a total of £88,411 awarded to groups.

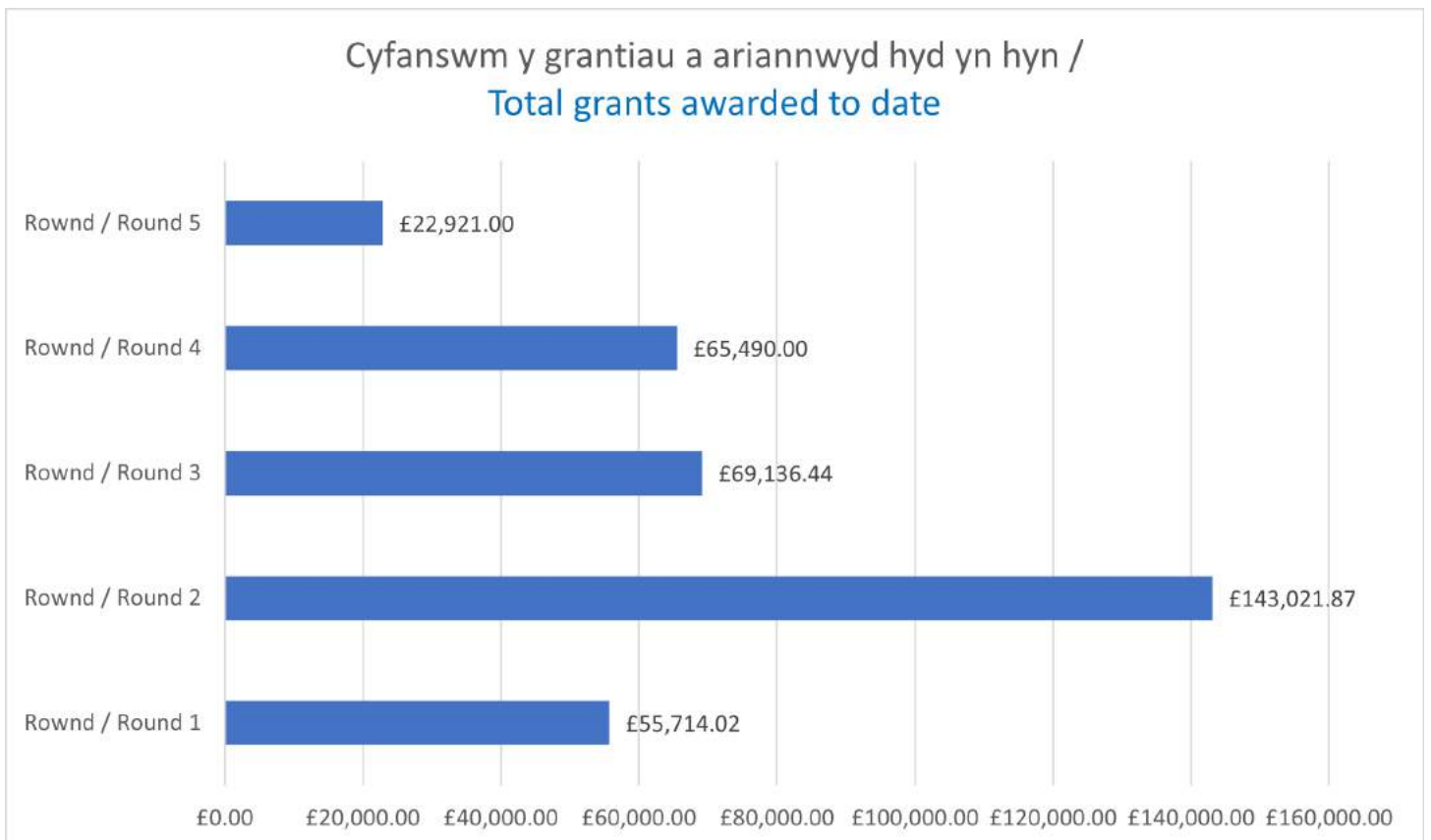

The fund is having a positive impact on the local community with individuals and groups clearly acknowledging the difference the fund is making to their area.

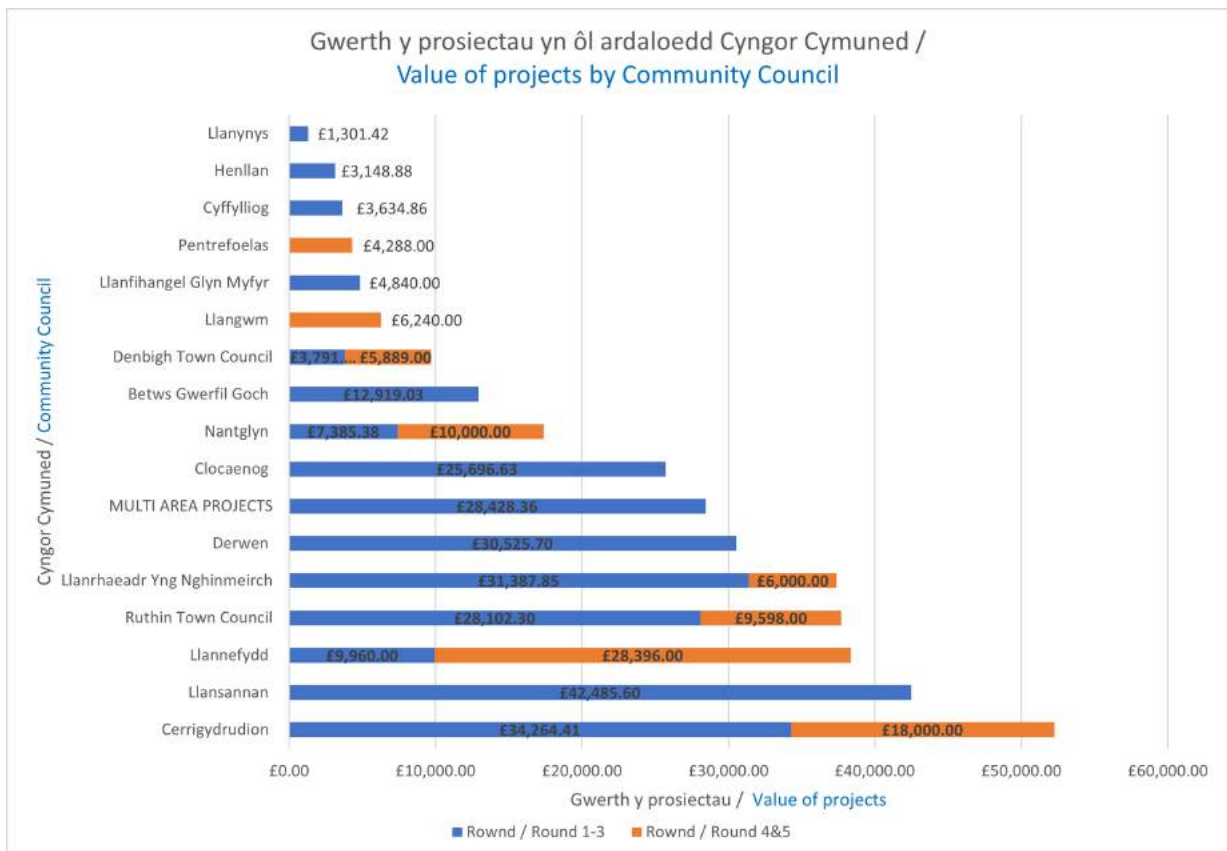
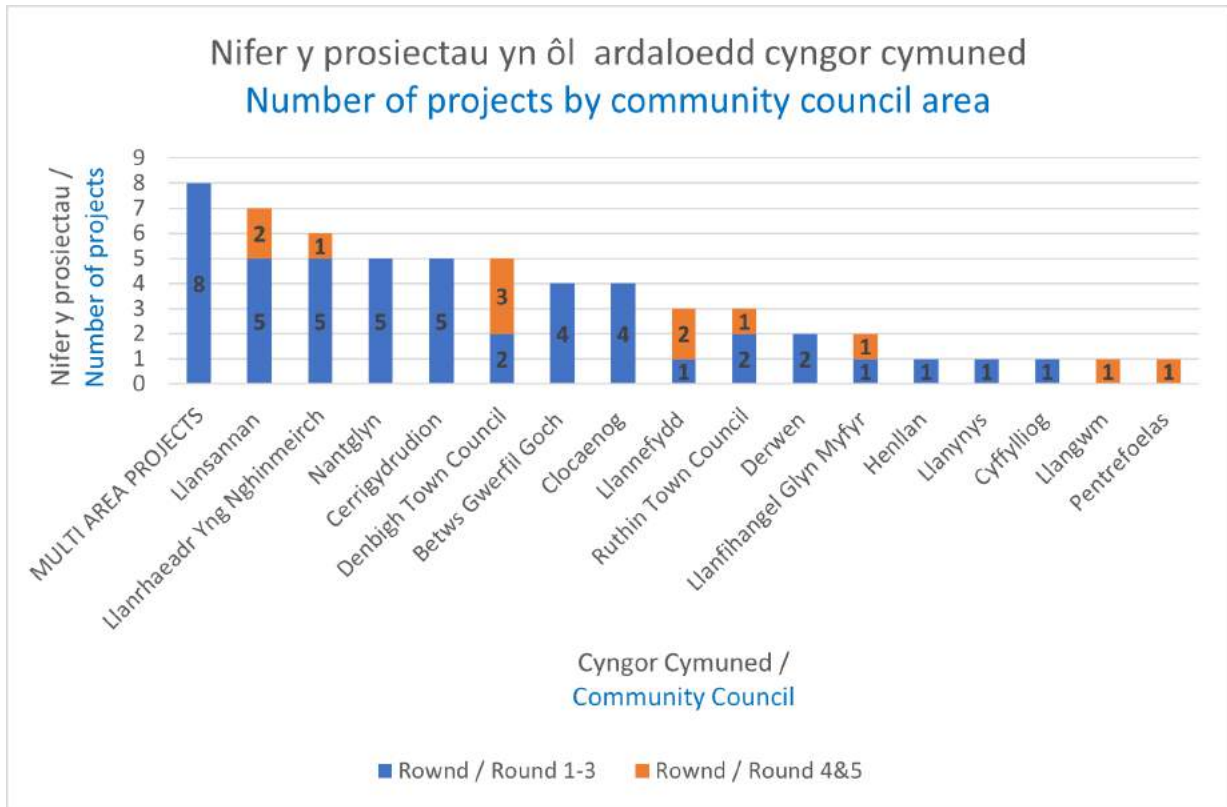

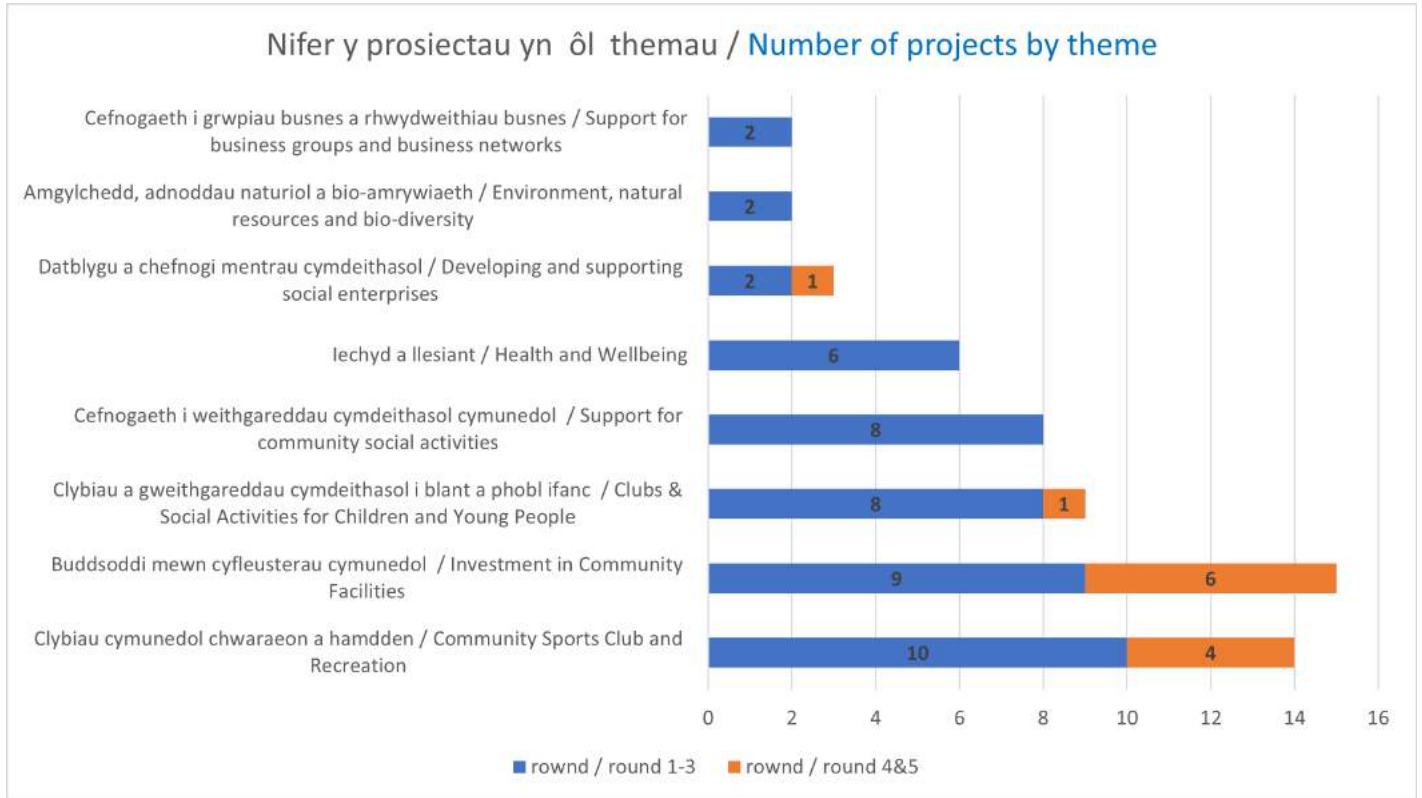

Mae plant y fro hefyd yn defnyddio Cae Chwarae Clocaenog yn ogystal â phlant y pentref. Yn wahanol i gaeau chwarae cymunedol eraill, mae Cae Chwarae Clocaenog yn elusen o dan ofal grŵp bach o wirfoddolwyr o'r pentref. Dydy'r cae chwarae ddim yn derbyn unrhyw gyllid Cyngor Cymuned nac ychwaith gan y Llywodraeth. Mae'r grŵp felly yn dibynnu'n fawr ar godi arian a chyfraniadau i gynnal a chadw a thrwsio cyfarpar sydd wedi torri. Bu hi'n anodd iawn mynd ati i godi arian i gynnal a chadw'r parc yn sgil COVID-19. Rydw i felly, fel Cadeirydd prosiect Cae Chwarae Clocaenog yn hynod ddiolchgar am gefnogaeth ariannol Brenig Wind.

Bu i'r grant ein cynorthwyo i brynu cyfarpar newydd yn lle hen gyfarpar oedd wedi torri a'i gondemnio er mwyn i blant eu mwynhau am flynyddoedd maith. Unwaith eto mae gennym ni gyfleuster addas i'w bwrpas anhygoel y gallai pawb ei fwynhau ac mae hynny gyda diolch i Fferm Wynt Brenig.

Clocaenog Playground is used not only by the village children, but also children from surrounding villages. Unlike other community playgrounds, Clocaenog's Playground is a charity run by a small group of volunteer's within the village. It doesn't receive any government or Community Council funding and so relies heavily on fundraising and donations to maintain and replace broken equipment. COVID-19 has made raising funds to maintain the park very difficult, so as Chair of the Clocaenog Playground project, I am extremely grateful to receive the financial support of the Brenig Wind.

The grant has enabled us to replace broken and condemned equipment with new equipment for the children to play with for many years to come. We now once again have an amazing fit for purpose facility for all to use and that's all thanks to the Brenig Wind Farm.
